Competition: Sonoma GT World Challenge Race 2


Facts: After the conclusion of Race 2, the Series Technical Department conducted inspections and generated a Technical Infraction Acknowledgement form (Sequence #004) for the No. 3 and No. 6 KPAX cars. The technical infraction noted was "incorrect engine RPM reported", as recorded by the Series-required Motec data system. This is a violation of Sporting Regulations Article 27.6 – "Data Logger". That article requires that the required data logger be installed and correctly configured.

The Stewards held a hearing with the Series Technical Manager, team representatives from KPAX, and the manufacturers representative. It was determined that, while the manufacturer's Bosch data system showed measured technical parameters to be within compliance, the data scaling on the Series-required data recorder was incorrectly configured, generating data that indicated non-compliance. The three parties heard from at the hearing all agreed that this was a configuration issue that generated anomalous data, and was unrelated to actual performance.


Supporting Documents: Technical Infraction Acknowledgement Sequence # 004; Series Technical Manager's Data Infraction Report for the Nos 3 & 6 GT3 KPAX cars.

Decision: The Stewards, having reviewed the supporting documents and after considering the evidence, find that car nos 3 & 6 had violated Article 27.6, but that this was a configuration error that did not affect performance. While a de minimis violation, it does contravene the Sporting Regulations. The Steward admonish the competitor and impose a \$500 fine, suspended. If the competitor demonstrates compliance to the Series Technical Department at the beginning of the next event, the fine will be rescinded.

The competitor is reminded of his right to appeal (Article 18) except the penalties which are not susceptible to appeal.
